

MINUTES OF THE WHEELING SENIOR COMMISSION

- 1- Call to Order. The January 9, 2020, meeting of the Wheeling Senior Commission was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by chairman Marshall Kaplan
- 2- Roll Call. Pat Miller took roll all and Isabella Licciardello and Officer Laverd were the only members absent.
- 3- Approval of Minutes. Upon motion duly made by Michael Kohen and seconded by Pat Hawkins the minutes of the December 2019 meeting were approved as submitted.
