## From the Desk of President Argiris

You may not know it, but the Village of Wheeling is home to Illinois' third busiest airport—Chicago Executive Airport (CEA). The airport plays an important role in the local economy and also brings new and exciting events to the Village for the benefit of its residents. In July, CEA played host to the “Wings of Freedom” tour put on by the Collings Foundation. The tour features old war planes such as the B-17, B-24, and the P-51 Mustang, which can all be viewed and toured by attendees. In September, CEA will be the exclusive airport of the BMW Golf Championship held in Lake Forest. This event will bring many corporate jets, professional golfers, and advertisers through CEA and the Village of Wheeling. I am very proud of our airport for having been chosen.

In other business news, Wheeling welcomed the opening of the new Dunkin Donuts at 213 E. Dundee Road in June. In July, construction of a new retail building began at the Lexington Commons shopping center as part of a complete exterior renovation. Half of the new building is leased to Starbucks Coffee, and the adjacent 2,000 sq. ft. unit is being marketed.

In early August, a new ownership entity acquired the Westin Chicago North Shore. The new owners plan to maintain the Westin brand and invest approximately \$6 to \$7 million into the property. Also in August, new owners of the Prairie Crossings shopping center closed on their purchase of the property in front of the Westin and they are actively working to bring new tenants to the shopping center.

Finally, in the heart of town, a significant building block for the Town Center District fell into place when the Northgate Crossings development was unanimously approved by the Village Board in early August. This development will add 288 residential units to the downtown district.

The Korean Cultural Center of Chicago (KCCOC) celebrated their two year anniversary in Wheeling in June. Village representatives attended the celebration to participate in the festivities and recognize the KCCOC for the substantial contributions it has made to the civic and cultural life of our community. Village Staff and I were lucky enough to attend the inauguration of President Tom Chong-II of the Korean American Association of Chicago. The event was attended by a variety of Korean dignitaries as well as by Governor Pat Quinn, State Treasurer Dan Rutherford, members of the KCCOC, and elected officials from throughout the Chicago Metropolitan Area. It was truly an honor to be included.

Clearly, the new face of Wheeling is really taking shape. In addition, our schools are striving towards excellence and helping our children prepare for their futures. Recently, Wheeling High School student Jess Musto received a gold medal and placed third nationally at the Family Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) fashion design “STAR” event. I commend her and Wheeling High School on this great achievement! We clearly have much to be proud of as Wheeling residents and as always, I look forward with great anticipation to see what’s next for this great Village of ours!

## Storm Drain Grate/Inlet Cleaning



**The Village encourages residents to help in the effort of removing debris from grates/inlets near properties.**

Storm drain grates/inlets help collect water which then flows to the nearest stream, river or lake and are normally located near the edge of streets or in yards. Grates/inlets obstructed with leaves and other debris (i.e. grass clippings, tree seeds, etc.) do not allow for a continual water flow and may cause localized flooding. If an obstructed grate/inlet is found, residents should rake the debris away from the storm drain. Do not stuff the debris into the grate/inlet or blow the debris into the street. Please do not remove debris from grates/inlets in an active storm; standing on or near metal grates in a lightning storm is very unsafe. Depending on the type of debris, it may be disposed of as yard waste or garbage. If there is a larger concern, residents may contact the Public Works Department at 847.279.6900.

## Street Patching & Resurfacing

This street maintenance program will consist of approximately 24,000 square yards of street patching and roadway resurfacing at various locations throughout the Village. This project is meant as maintenance, not a complete roadway resurfacing or reconstruction project. Certain areas will have pavement grinding performed along curbs, and out six to eight feet from the curb line. Once the deteriorated asphalt has been milled out, new asphalt will be placed in the area. By doing this remedial work, we will be able to extend the life of our streets by five to seven years. The project is anticipated to begin in early September.

## Water Meter Upgrade Program

The Village of Wheeling has implemented a Village-wide water meter upgrade program to replace existing water meters. Here's what you need to know!

- All residential, commercial and industrial meters are being replaced during this program.
- The Village has contracted with United Meters, Inc. (UMI) to complete the installation.
- Notices are being sent requesting residents to schedule an installation appointment with UMI. Additionally, UMI is also going door-to-door requesting to upgrade meters.
- UMI installers have appropriate photo identification with them at all times and are driving company marked vehicles.
- In preparation of the meter upgrade, the Village of Wheeling is requesting that residents ensure the area where their water meter is located is free from clutter so as to allow UMI employees quick access to the area.
- The meter change-out normally takes approximately 15 minutes.

Currently, over 4,200 meters have been upgraded and the project is 52% complete. The Village of Wheeling thanks you, and appreciates your cooperation and patience during the installation of the new water meter. This technology upgrade is an important step in the future of our community.

## Parkway Tree Planting Program

The Village of Wheeling has an ongoing Parkway Tree Planting Program during which trees are planted in locations where dead or hazardous trees were removed. In order to maintain a diverse urban forest, several different species of trees are selected for planting through this program. Parkway tree planting happens twice a year: spring planting occurs between April and June, and the fall planting occurs between September and November. ## Leaves, Leaves, Leaves

**Village Code 11.08.100 prohibits the deposit of leaves into streets, roads, or highways and along the shoulder, curb or edge of any street, road or highway.**

Leaves intentionally raked into such areas can result in clogged storm sewer drains and flooding.

 The Village's contract with Waste Management provides an alternate, convenient method to dispose of leaves and other forms of yard waste for single-family residents.

 In addition to 2-ply Kraft biodegradable paper yard waste bags, residents may use rigid 32-gallon containers clearly marked with a red 'X' around the container.

 Containers and biodegradable bags, when filled, may not exceed 45 pounds in weight. There is no limit to the number of yard waste bags or containers.

 Yard waste in plastic bags or cardboard boxes will not be collected.

 Brush must be bundled and tied with biodegradable twine or string. Bundles must not weigh over 45 lbs., exceed four feet in length or two feet in diameter, or contain limbs greater than three inches in diameter. There is no limit to the number of bundled brush.

 Loose, or larger brush or logs, will not be collected by Waste Management.

 Yard waste collections conclude on November 30, 2013.



The Wheeling Food Pantry is the initiative of the Wheeling Rotary Club and is supported by several community organizations including the Village of Wheeling, OMNI Youth Services, St. Joseph the Worker Church, Wheeling High School and School District 21. Social Services staff from the Village of Wheeling as well as from OMNI Youth Services is available during pantry hours to provide visitors with additional services as needed. We are an agency for the Greater Chicago Food Depository. Our mission is to try to help those in need with their financial, physical and/or emotional problems so that they may lead normal, self-sustaining, independent lives.

**Requirements for utilizing the Food Pantry:** Patrons must be either Wheeling residents or have children who attend School District 21 or Wheeling High School. Patrons must bring proof of residency (driver's license or other official identification, utility bill, lease, mortgage, or a letter from School District 21 or Wheeling High School). Qualifying patrons may utilize the food pantry once every 30 days.

## School Zone Safety Reminder


School is officially in session in Wheeling, which means children are now walking to and from school. The Wheeling Police Department wants YOU to be aware of the following:

### School Zones:

The speed limit in all Wheeling school zones is 20 miles per hour. “School Days” are defined as 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. on days when school is in session and children are present on the sidewalks or in the area. First offenses carry a minimum fine of \$150. A court appearance by the violator is required. Court supervision cannot be given to drivers cited for speeding in a school zone.

### Stopping for loading and unloading school buses:

Illinois law requires that drivers stop and not pass school buses that have their red lights flashing with the stop sign arm extended. Vehicles that are in oncoming traffic in relation to a stopped school bus on a four lane roadway are not required to stop under the law. A court appearance by violators is required. First offenders are subject to a mandatory minimum fine of \$150, are not eligible for court supervision, and will have their driver’s license suspended for a period of three months.



### Disobeying a Crossing Guard:

Illinois law makes disobeying a Crossing Guard a moving violation. A court appearance by violators is required. The minimum fine is \$150.

### Cellular phone use in a School Zone:

Cellular phone use when driving in school zones is prohibited by state law, except in emergencies (for example when calling the police, fire or ambulance). Cellular phones may be used in “hands-free” mode in school zones. Cellular phone use is also prohibited in construction work zones.

### Texting while driving:

Texting while driving is prohibited at all times throughout the state of Illinois. The law defines texting as “electronic mail, a text message, an instant message or a command or request to access an internet site.”

## Community Assisted Relief Efforts Seeks Volunteers

Have you ever wondered how to get involved and help your community in an emergency or disaster? Community Assisted Relief Efforts (CARE) is a group of community volunteers who are trained and prepared to assist victims of disasters with shelter and comfort. This group was instrumental in sheltering the victims of the most recent Wheeling flood in April of this year. Volunteers are trained in Red Cross Shelter Operations, CPR/AED/First Aid, and emergency procedures. CARE is a group partnership between the Wheeling Police, Fire, and Human Services Departments. ## Don't Block the Sidewalk!

The Wheeling Police Department would like to remind you that blocking the sidewalks with a parked vehicle makes it dangerous for people who are walking, pushing strollers or riding bikes on those sidewalks.

***It is against Village Ordinance to park blocking sidewalks between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.***

Village Ordinance 9.10.107(a)18 states, “No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle on a sidewalk, except between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., when vehicles may be parked in residence districts on that portion of the sidewalk which connects the driveway and the driveway apron.”
