- 1) Please call 847-459-2960 to leave a voicemail message no later than 12:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting. Village Code rules pertaining to Citizen Concerns and Comments in Section 2.03.060(a) of the Village Code and pertaining to Decorum in Section 2.03.180 of the Village Code will apply to such voicemail messages. Voicemail messages may not exceed five (5) minutes in length. Voicemails left before 12:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting in accordance with Sections 2.03.060(a) and 2.03.180 of the Village Code will be played at the meeting during Citizen Concerns and Comments.
- 2) Members of the public may address the commission in person at the Village Hall Board Room with comments regarding only those items that are relevant to commission business. Issues relevant to commission business are defined to mean information about commission events; issues that the public body has the authority to address; items listed on the agenda; and items or issues previously voted on by the commission or that the commission has the authority to consider or vote on in the future. No citizen shall speak for more than five minutes without consent of the commission. The Chairperson shall strictly restrain comments and questions to matters that are relevant to commission business and shall not permit repetitious comments or arguments. Members of the public who wish to address the commission must sign the request to speak form prior to the commencement of the public meeting.
