

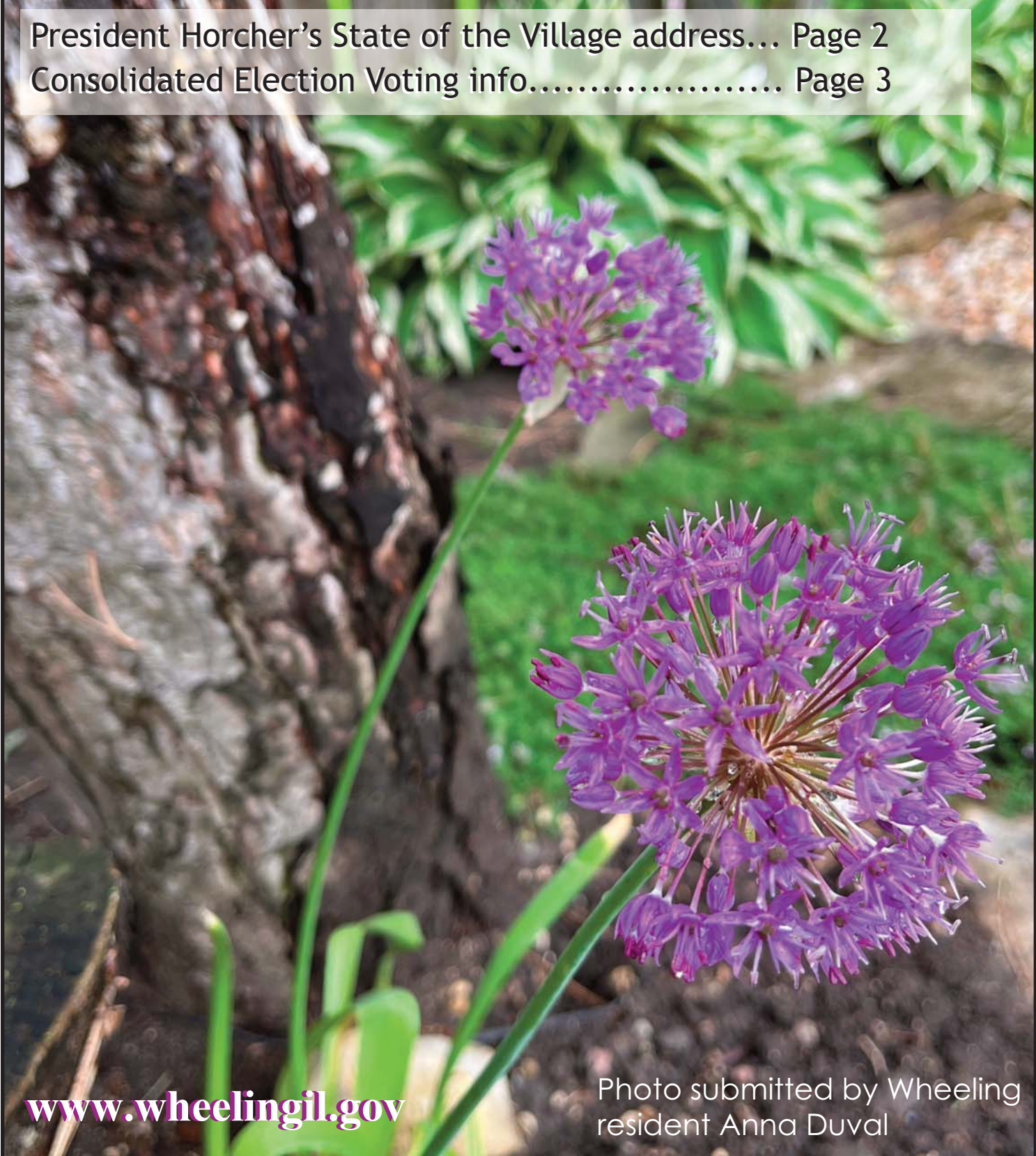

## 2023 State of the Village Address

A new year has begun, spring is around the corner, and it's time once again to provide an update on the state of the Village of Wheeling. While challenges remain, as challenges always do, I'm pleased to report that the Village remains on solid financial footing thanks to careful management of costs and to strong revenues from sales and income taxes. Given our fiscal stability, and in recognition of the ongoing impact of inflation on Wheeling residents and businesses, last year the Village Board was able to forego an increase in the annual property tax levy.

The staff had another busy year, overseeing our own Village projects and coordinating with state, county, and local partners on other notable undertakings, which included the completion of major upgrades to both Lake Cook and Wolf Roads. Large projects like these—which include improvements to both the roadway surface and underground utilities—provide significant long-term benefits to the community, but are certainly an inconvenience while they're underway, and we're grateful for the patience of residents and organizations along these corridors. We made many other improvements, too: to neighborhood streets, the water system, storm and sanitary sewers, sidewalks and footbridges, streetlights, emergency apparatus, even the software that staff uses to manage tasks—all of which are assets that tend to be invisible until they break down. As is the case with many of the Village's core services, the best evidence of our success is the fact that the public rarely has a reason to be aware of our efforts.

Progress in the private sector tends to be easier to see, and Wheeling has seen a lot of it in the past year, including Cinergy's occupancy of the movie theater at Wheeling Town Center, and the openings of District Brew Yards at the former Ram site, Starbucks by the Westin hotel, and Okay Dispensary and West Town Bakery at the former Twin Peaks. As of this writing, more openings are imminent—including Yu's Mandarin on South Milwaukee and Popeyes on East Dundee—and construction is proceeding on developments including Union Apartments on Wheeling Road, the townhomes at Prairie Park, and the London Crossing mixed-use development on Dundee Road, where School District 21's new office building is now complete. Early this year, Chicago-based Rosebud Steakhouse announced that it will open a Wheeling location in Uptown 500 at Dundee and Northgate Parkway, adding another chapter to Wheeling's long history as a dining destination.

That history connects us with Wheeling's origins as a village and remains a source of strong community pride. It's one reason why the Board of Trustees adopted the Restaurant Row Corridor Plan, a far-reaching analysis and set of recommendations for ensuring the continued vitality of Milwaukee Avenue as a home for world-class hospitality businesses. I think every member of the Wheeling community—residents and businesses alike—will find the Plan interesting and informative, and I encourage everyone to visit our website and take a look. It's only one of many ways the Village is laying the groundwork for a prosperous future. Plans to construct a free-standing Fire Station 42 west of the railroad tracks continue to move ahead, and we're doing preliminary engineering for major projects that include improvements to Northgate Parkway, Chaddick Drive, and Wheeling Road, as well as water main and storm sewer upgrades on South Milwaukee near Chicago Executive Airport, and stormwater-related projects at Ecko Lake and along Buffalo Creek. Whenever possible we'll seek state and federal funding for these projects, most of which will deliver benefits beyond our borders. And we'll continue to promote development and economic activity whenever appropriate through the Restaurant & Retail Build-Out Grant program, other tax increment financing approaches, and the judicious support of Cook County property tax incentives for qualifying projects, as well as by maintaining open lines of communication with current and prospective Wheeling businesses about their present needs and future plans.

I'll close this year's update with thanks—first to the members of the Village staff for their hard work and expertise. In addition to supervising day-to-day operations, Village Manager Jon Sfondilis continues to advocate for Wheeling's interests in several capacities, including current terms on the board of the Northwest Water Commission, as a member of the North Shore Council of Mayors Technical Committee, and as the chair of the executive committee of the Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County. Other Village staffers also work cooperatively with regional partners in ways too numerous to mention while maintaining the quality services that the community relies on, and we're grateful for their efforts. I also want to express appreciation to our commissioners and other volunteers for their generosity and community spirit. Finally, my thanks to the Village Trustees for speaking their minds while finding ways to work toward the common good. I'm honored to serve with them, and all of us are grateful for the opportunity to serve Wheeling. We'll be back with more updates in 2 the months ahead. Until then, we hope this finds you well!

### Vote April 4, 2023

On Tuesday, April 4, Wheeling residents will have the opportunity to vote for three Village Trustees. Visit [www.cookcountyclerk.com](http://www.cookcountyclerk.com) to see a sample ballot, verify your voter registration, determine your polling place, request a mail ballot, and find early voting locations. Early voting takes place March 20–April 3. You can request a mail ballot from now until March 30. Once you receive your mail ballot, it must be completed and postmarked by Election Day and received no later than 14 days after Election Day to be counted. Anyone can apply for a mail ballot, no excuses needed.



If you are not yet registered, you can do so at the Village Hall Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. You may also register online at [www.ova.elections.il.gov](http://www.ova.elections.il.gov). The last day to register to vote for the Consolidated Election is March 7 for in-person registration and March 19 for online registration.

## Celebrating National Social Work Month

More than 700,000 professional social workers are hard at work in our nation, and that number is expected to rise to more than 800,000 by 2030. Social workers enter the profession because they have a strong desire to help empower individuals, families, communities, and our nation to overcome issues that prevent them from reaching their full potential.

The Village of Wheeling has professional social workers available to all residents of Wheeling for a myriad of services.

- » Are you a student who needs athletic shoes to participate in sports, but your parents can't afford to buy them? Talk to your school social worker. They can help you find the resources you need.
- » Do you want a better relationship with your spouse, children, or parents? Talk to a social worker. They can help you find a way to make your connections with each other stronger.
- » Are you suffering from depression, anxiety, or substance-use disorder? A social worker can give you strategies and guidance to surmount mental illness and addiction. Most therapists are social workers.
- » Do you think a child or older adult is suffering from abuse or neglect? Or are you interested in growing your family through foster care and adoption? There are social workers ready to help.

## National Crime Victims' Rights Week

National Crime Victims' Rights Week (NCVRW) is an annual observance bringing communities together to educate the public about victims' rights, protections, and services. This year's theme—Survivor Voices: Elevate. Engage. Effect Change—calls upon communities to amplify the voices of survivors and create environments where survivors have the confidence that they will be heard, believed, and supported.



The Village of Wheeling Social Services Division, working within the Wheeling Police Department, has provided and will continue to provide strength, resilience, and justice for victims of crime individually, for their families, and for the community collectively.

In the last year, Victim Services staff provided services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, and elder abuse. These victims received crisis counseling and intervention in English and Spanish, court escort and court advocacy,, assistance with preparation of Victim Impact Statements, and transportation to and from court. Victims were assisted with petitions for all types of protective orders through the court. Victims were also provided with short-term counseling and assistance with tangible needs such as food, housing, and finances.

Assistance can be provided to access public benefits, child support, and legal referrals and resources. Victim Services staff are also able to assist with the application to the Illinois Crime Victim Compensation Program, which may help victims pay for out-of-pocket expenses such as counseling, funeral expenses, and lost wages.

No crime victim is the same. Their unique experience and how they heal affect and are affected by the intervention, services, and resources provided to them to promote emotional and financial stability and self-sufficiency. The Village of Wheeling Social Services Division is proud to be a part of this healing process and to be a positive impact in victims' lives. ## Floods Are No Myth: Be Prepared for the Unexpected

Discounts on flood insurance are just one of many benefits residents enjoy as a result of Wheeling's proactive approach to flood hazard damage reduction. A 45-year member of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), Wheeling has joined a national effort to minimize property damage in cases of flooding and provide affordable flood insurance to all homeowners, whether or not they are located in or near a floodplain. As part of its NFIP commitment, the Village provides a range of information on flooding potential, prevention, safety, and other issues. ### Local Flood Hazard Potential

The Village's proximity to waterways such as the Des Plaines River, Buffalo Creek, and McDonald Creek raises the hazard of flooding during heavy rains. Standard homeowner's insurance does not cover flooding. Through the 1960s, private rates on flood insurance were prohibitively high, which made it almost impossible to carry flood insurance. The NFIP, formed in 1968, is designed to subsidize the cost of flood insurance to member communities, qualify them to receive disaster relief, and establish minimum national standards to reduce flood losses.

### High CRS Rating

One of eight inaugural NFIP communities in Illinois, Wheeling designed programs to exceed minimum standards and optimize benefits to Village residents. In 1992, the NFIP implemented the Community Rating System (CRS) to reward communities that go above and beyond the basic requirements. Effective May 1, 2014, our rating was upgraded to Class 6, which provides a 20% discount on flood insurance policies for properties located within the special flood hazard area. Policies issued for properties outside the special flood hazard area continue to receive a 5% discount. Wheeling continues to be proactive in preventative initiatives, including:

**Stream maintenance:** Regular inspections of waterways to ensure they are clear of debris and potential obstructions.

**Regulating new construction:** New buildings in the flood zone must meet requirements for elevation and flood-proofing. Village planners ensure that new developments don't increase flood risk for neighbors in the community.

**Keeping residents informed of flood risk and how to minimize impact:** Our residents must be aware of the potential for flooding. Tools such as this newsletter enable us to keep residents informed regarding the risk of flooding.

### Development Regulated

Development of any type within special flood hazard areas is strictly regulated. In order to construct a building or an addition, perform any grading, or fill any other type of construction in these

areas, an individual must obtain a special "floodplain development permit." This permit is issued in conjunction with other construction permits to assure that the new construction will not be susceptible to flood damage or cause increased flood damage potential to neighboring properties. Floodplain development regulations can be found on the Village's website at [www.wheelingil.gov](http://www.wheelingil.gov) in Title 22 of the Municipal Code (a link to which can be found on the home page) or by contacting the Engineering Division at 847.279.6910.

*With flooding a possibility, especially during the spring/summer season, preparation is the best defense. Safeguarding people, protecting buildings, and purchasing flood insurance are keys to defending against floods.*

**Protect Your Property:** To flood-proof a structure, start by elevating or relocating electrical panel boxes, furnaces, water heaters, and washer/dryers to areas least likely to be flooded. Install basement floor drains and interior and exterior backwater valves. Consider erecting interior flood walls around utilities. Move essential items and furniture to the upper floors of your home. Keep materials such as sandbags, plywood, plastic sheeting, and lumber handy for emergency waterproofing. More flood protection information is available from FEMA through the "Floodplain/Flooding Information" link on the home page of our website at [www.wheelingil.gov](http://www.wheelingil.gov). Information is also available for review at the Indian Trails Public Library.

**Personal Safety:** During periods of high water, stay out of the basement where breaker boxes and electrical wiring present the risk of shock. If you know high water is imminent, shut off the electricity, gas, and water. Keep your family together and make sure everyone has identification. Move everyone—including pets—to high ground. Rescue crews cannot reach you once the water becomes two feet deep. Don't drive across flooded roads where your vehicle could stall. Flowing water above your knees can generate dangerous currents; avoid walking through it.

**Village Monitors Rising Water Levels:** The Village monitors rising water levels with strategically placed gauges. Comparing data with historic records, the Village can predict areas of potential flooding. In the event of a flooding situation, Village staff is mobilized to notify people in affected areas. In some situations, notification may be made by phone. Road closure information is available from radio stations.

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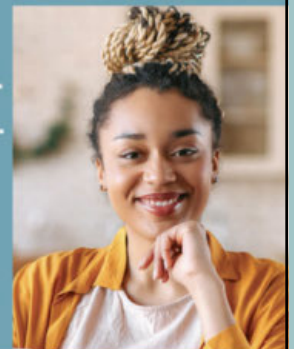

# COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & PUBLIC WORKS

## What is Arbor Day?

The Village of Wheeling will be celebrating Arbor Day as part of the Village's Tree City USA program, which affords staff and residents the opportunity to celebrate the many benefits trees provide to the environment by planting a ceremonial tree. Over the last several years, the grounds surrounding many of the local schools have been the site for planting a wide variety of trees. ## Yard Waste Collections



Yard waste collections begin on April 1 and continue through November 30 on your regularly-scheduled collection days. Townhouses and condominiums do not have this service.

- Yard waste must be placed in paper bags or in a container clearly marked with a red X (cannot be in plastic bags or cardboard boxes). Bags and containers must not be larger than 32 gallons or exceed 50 pounds. There is no limit to the number of bags or containers.

- All yard waste must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. the day of collection, but not before 5 p.m. the evening before.

- Brush must be bundled and tied with twine or string. Bundles must not weigh over 50 pounds, exceed four feet in length or two feet in diameter, or contain limbs greater than three inches in diameter. There is no limit to the number of brush bundles.

## Reporting Potholes

Certain roadways in Wheeling are not maintained by the Village. Please contact the correct agency below to report potholes on these roadways.

## Stormwater Runoff Pollution

Stormwater runoff is generated when precipitation from rain and snowmelt flows over land or impervious surfaces and does not percolate into the ground. Stormwater runoff that flows over impervious surfaces such as streets, driveways, concrete areas, and rooftops, collects debris, chemicals, sediments, and other pollutants that enter the storm sewer system. The Village storm sewer effluent flows directly into detention basins, creeks, streams, rivers, and lakes, bypassing the partial cleaning typically performed at sanitary sewer treatment plants.



Pollutants that exist in stormwater runoff can include motor oil, antifreeze/transmission fluid, paint, solvents/degreasers, detergents, pet and yard waste, dirt and gravel, trash, pesticides, and fertilizers. Public Works personnel constantly extract some of this waste from the system for efficient flow. Residents and businesses can take measures to prevent stormwater runoff pollution from entering our storm sewer system, such as:

- Repair vehicle leaks and dispose of used auto fluids at designated drop-off facilities.
- Apply pesticides and fertilizers only as necessary; use organic mulch and reduce application of outside pest controls whenever possible.
- Compost and/or mulch yard waste, and follow local yard waste programs. Do not deposit or leave yard waste in the street.
- Remove and properly dispose of litter and debris from properties, including sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots.
- Remove and properly dispose of construction debris.
- Clean up after pets. Village Municipal Code 7.10 requires removal of pet waste on public and private property.

## Storm Drain Grate/Inlet Cleaning

Storm drain grates/inlets are normally located near the edge of streets or in rear yards, collecting water which uses the storm sewer system to ultimately flow into streams, rivers, or lakes. Grates/inlets obstructed with leaves and other debris can deny constant water flow and can cause localized flooding. As snow melt occurs in spring, the Village encourages residents to safely clear storm sewer grates/inlets near their property to avoid local flooding issues. If a grate/inlet is obstructed, residents should rake the debris off of the structure and onto the parkway or into a waste container. If ponding or another concern arises, contact Public Works at 847.279.6900.

## WHERE SHOULD YOU STORE YOUR GARBAGE CANS?

Per the Wheeling Municipal Code, garbage and recycling cans should be stored:

-  On the side of your house
-  In the rear of your house
-  Or in your garage



 Please do not place cans in front of your home or in your front yard.

Please note that cans should not be placed at the curb before 5pm the day before a scheduled collection, and must be removed by 8am the day after collection.

## Annual Hydrant Flushing

Public Works will be flushing hydrants throughout the Village from May 1 through May 16, weather permitting. Hydrant flushing will occur between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and will continue until all portions of the water distribution system have been completed. Signs will be posted while hydrant flushing is underway.

Flushing is an important preventative maintenance process undertaken to remove particulate matter and corrosion from the system. You may notice slightly lower pressure and discoloration of your water throughout the duration of the program; however, the water is completely safe to drink. It is advised to check the color of the water before beginning laundry to prevent staining.

## Public Works Seasonal Positions

The Department of Public Works frequently has temporary, seasonal positions available during the summer for individuals interested in acquiring experience in the profession. These positions perform diverse duties with the majority of work done outdoors. Duties include assisting with streets, litter collection, parkway restorations, sign maintenance, water and sewer maintenance, facilities, light clerical, etc. as well as other work assigned. Applicants are required to be 18 years old or older, have a high school diploma or equivalent, successfully pass a mandatory medical exam including drug screening, have a valid Illinois driver's license, and be able to lift, carry, and handle objects that weigh up to 50 lbs. 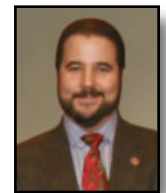
